The Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") received the above referenced Petition on December 29, 2014. A data request to New Horizons Communications Corp. was issued on February 5, 2015, and a response received by the TRA on February 26, 2015. The Petition is still under review and has not yet been approved by the TRA.

On March 31, 2015, the TRA received a Form UD-16 Statement of Gross Earnings and Computation of Inspection Fee form on behalf of New Horizons Communications Corp. indicating \$7,734 in Intrastate revenue for the calendar year 2014.

Please advise as to whether New Horizons Communications Corp. is providing telecommunications services in Tennessee without the proper authority granted by the TRA.
