Petitioner New Horizons Communications Corp., through its undersigned attorney, responds to the Tennessee Regulatory Authority's ("TRA") April 1, 2015 information request in the above-referenced Docket: 1

Question: On March 31, 2015, the TRA received a Form UD-16 Statement of Gross Earnings and Computation of Inspection Fee form on behalf of New Horizons Communications Corp. indicating \$7,734 in Intrastate revenue for the calendar year 2014. Please advise as to whether New Horizons Communications Corp. is providing telecommunications services in Tennessee without the proper authority granted by the TRA.

Response: New Horizons Communications Corp. ("NHC") is not providing telecommunications services in Tennessee at this time without the proper authority granted by the TRA. Compliance Solutions, Inc., which filed NHC's March 31, 2015 Statement of Gross Earnings and Computation of Inspection Fee ("Statement") that in turn prompted TRA Staff's April 1, 2015 information request in this Docket, has informed NHC that the \$7,734 in revenues that were reported on this Statement were associated with VoIP/Internet services. Out of an abundance of caution, Compliance Solutions reported these revenues on the "long distance" line on this Statement because it believed this was the appropriate line to report such revenues. Based on Compliance Solutions' further review, it intends to withdraw this March 31, 2015 filing/Statement because these VoIP/Internet service revenues do not fall within the TRA's

jurisdiction.
