Dear Mr. Baltimore,

The Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") received a Wireline Activity Report on April 30, 2015, submitted by Compliance Solutions, Inc. ("CSI") on behalf of New Horizons Communications Corp. ("New Horizons"), indicating that New Horizons had 6 switched voice grade equivalent access lines in service in Knox County, Tennessee for the month ending March 31, 2015.

Please provide a notarized statement from an officer of New Horizons indicating whether or not the company is providing voice telecommunications services in Tennessee.

If New Horizons is providing voice telecommunications services in Tennessee, please state New Horizon's position on how providing telecommunications services in Tennessee is not a violation of Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201 (b), § 65-4-125(j) and Tenn. Comp. R. and Regs 1220-4-8-.02.

If New Horizons is not providing voice telecommunications services in Tennessee, and it is outsourcing 100% of its regulatory compliance to CSI, explain why Compliance Solutions, Inc. submitted both a UD-16 form on March 31, 2015 to the Tennessee Regulatory Authority indicating that New Horizons had intrastate revenue for 2014 and a Wireline Activity Report on April 30, 2015, indicating New Horizons was providing 6 switched voice grade equivalent access lines in Knox County, Tennessee for the month ending March 31, 2015.

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 pm on May 15, 2015 and that you reference Docket Number 14-00169 on the response. In accordance with TRA rules submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version.
