ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF FOR SIXTY (60) DAYS

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 12, 2015. On December 30, 2014, Tennessee-American Water Company ("TAWC") filed a *Petition* requesting approval of a proposed Production Costs and Other Pass-Throughs Rider ("PCOP") percentage rate for 2015. The proposed tariff and documentation supporting the PCOP rate change were filed on January 6, 2015. The tariff changes have a proposed effective date of January 29, 2015.

During the Authority Conference, the panel found that additional time is needed to properly review and evaluate the proposed tariff changes and voted unanimously to suspend TAWC's proposed tariff for sixty (60) days from January 29, 2015.
