The Consumer Protection and Advocate Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate") does not oppose Kingsport Power Company's ("KPC") *Motion to Withdraw Petition for Approval of a Storm Damage Tariff Rider Without Prejudice for Later Refiling* ("Motion"), filed November 9, 2015, in this Docket 15-00024. As KPC stated in its *Motion*, the discovery of new information in response to Staff Data Request No. 3 may affect the amount of recovery sought for the 2013 Storm. Given this change and KPC recent base rate filing, which will require substantial resources from the Authority and all parties, the Consumer Advocate has no opposition to the *Motion*.
