CHAIRMAN HILLIARD: Okay. With that, without objection, we'll admit the application and the prefiled testimony into the record. Please present your petition.

MR. PICKNEY: Tennessee Wastewater
Systems, Incorporated, is petitioning the TRA to amend
our CCN to expand our service area to include a portion
of Williamson County known as The Scales Project. This
project is located off of Clovercroft Road in Williamson County. The parcel encompasses approximately
171 acres, and we seek to serve approximately 80
residential lots with this project, with a system that
would be built to serve approximately 24,000 gallons of
wastewater per day.

The TDEC application for a state operating permit was submitted, and we have a public hearing on August 18th on the status of that SOP. And the developer, Nicky Wells of Turnberry Homes, is the one that requested that we serve, and all the appropriate documents requesting our service and the

other providers in the area that passed on the service 1 are included in the petition. 2 CHAIRMAN HILLIARD: Okay. Does the 3 staff have any questions? 4 Do my fellow directors have any 5 questions of this witness? 6 7 DIRECTOR ALLISON: No. CHAIRMAN HILLIARD: Okay. You are 8 excused. 9 At this time I would like to invite any 10 member of the public who wishes to speak concerning the 11 petition to come forward at this time. 12 Let the record reflect that no one has 13 14 come forward to comment. If we are ready to deliberate, I have a 15 16 motion. Based on the administrative record and 17 testimony given today, I move that the petition be 18 approved contingent upon Tennessee Wastewater's 19 satisfactory filing of the following documents in this 20 docket: Deed and/or easements for all the land of the 21 wastewater system; final copy of the state operating 22 permit issued by TDEC; all final signed contracts 23 between Tennessee Wastewater, the builder of the 24 wastewater system, and Turnberry Homes; a copy of the 25

final signed plat from Williamson County; and a detailed cost itemization of the complete wastewater system transferred from the builder to Tennessee Wastewater.

with this motion, I would also like to note that I do have certain reservations about extending Tennessee Wastewater's CCN in light of the Maple Green and Cedar Hill wastewater facilities which, according to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, are in need of major repairs. I want to strongly emphasize my concerns related to these matters and direct staff to continue working with the Department of Environment and Conservation to closely monitor these situations and any others should they arise.

Therefore, I further move that

Tennessee Wastewater file detailed monthly reports to
explain all repairs and improvements made at Maple
Green and Cedar Hill, as well as the company's plans
for financing these projects. These monthly reports
should detail all projects that are won, that are
planned, in progress, and completed. For repairs that
are planned and in progress, Tennessee Wastewater
should provide a projected completion date and
estimated cost to complete the repair. For repairs and

improvements that have been completed, the completion date and actual cost of the project should be included in the report.

Should other compliance issues arise, cited by the Department of Environment and Conservation or any other regulatory entity or agency, concerning any of its wastewater system, Tennessee Wastewater should provide the Authority, on a timely basis, similar information concerning its plans for repairing those systems.

The first report should be filed September the 1st, 2014, with each subsequent update due the first of each month thereafter until the facilities are completely repaired.

As a final note, I want to encourage Tennessee Wastewater to prioritize its available resources to repair these troubled systems. I so move.

VICE CHAIRMAN JONES: I second and vote yes.

DIRECTOR ALLISON: I vote yes.
