**ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE  
AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 20, 2015.


On February 20, 2015, Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. ("TWSI") filed a Petition to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to expand its service area to include a portion of Williamson County in Tennessee known as Dove Lake. A *Petition to Intervene* was filed by the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate") on March 18, 2015. TWSI filed a response in opposition to the Consumer Advocate's *Petition to Intervene* on March 25, 2015, and the Consumer Advocate filed a response to TWSI's opposition on April 6, 2015.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint the Authority's General Counsel or her designee to act as Hearing Officer to prepare this matter for hearing, including but not limited to, establishing a procedural schedule, entering a protective order, and ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues.
