Systems subject to Notice of Violations and other Corrective Orders:

River Road* (NOV) – TWSI is awaiting a signed easement for the land occupied by the sewer system. This is the final requirement TDEC had for resolution of the NOV.

Hidden Springs (Order) – See attached bi-monthly progress reports as filed with TDEC per the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

Cross Plains (Order) – The drip fields have been installed and the lagoon taken offline per the terms of the Settlement Agreement with TDEC. The CAP 2 was submitted to TDEC in December and TWSI is awaiting approval of those plans so it can begin construction of the sand filter.

* There is no KPI Report because there is no discharge from the facility.

unsafe due to steep grade and constant rain.
