



Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. Docket 15-00025 March 2019 Report Overview

Systems subject to Notice of Violations and other Corrective Orders:

Starr Crest II (NOV) – Work is complete. TDEC inspection will be scheduled as soon as system is commissioned and accepted by the Utility.

Smoky Village (NOV) — Docket 16-00096 — Loan providing funds to expand the drip field has closed. The additional land needed has been purchased. Work is being scheduled.

Summit View - Docket 14-00136 - TDEC has reinstated the construction plans for the site.

Cedar Hill – Docket 16-00096 – Loan providing funds to build the sand filter has closed. Work has begun and is expected to be completed in the Spring.

Maple Green (NOV) – Docket 16-00096 – Loan providing funds to build the sand filter has closed. Work is being scheduled (will start after Cedar Hill is completed).

River Road* (NOV) – TWSI is awaiting a signed easement for the land occupied by the sewer system. This is the final requirement TDEC had for resolution of the NOV.

Hidden Springs Resort (Commissioner's Order) – Utility met with the HOA last month regarding obtaining an easement for the land needed to expand the treatment plant. A survey of the property is being scheduled so that the easement documents can be drawn up. A modified SOP application is being submitted to TDEC for approval. The Utility is hopeful that upon obtaining the easement, TDEC will approve the plans for expanding the system and construction can begin this Summer.

* River Road is not included in the KPI Report because there is no discharge from the facility and is not monitored.

Matt Nicks, Jeff Risden and I met onsite with the HOA group on Friday and had a lengthy discussion about the proposed repairs and easements that would be necessary to reconstruct the plant in a different location. The preliminary plans were presented to them along with a walk through of the existing facility and the proposed location of the new facility. The HOA has agreed to convey any land necessary to TWS that will make the wastewater issues go away. Jeff Risden and their attorneys will be diligently working through the details so the land conveyance wont hold up the process. Our biggest hold up may be getting a land surveyor out there to complete the survey.

Adenus Solutions Group will be submitting an SOP Mod Application today and is currently awaiting a PPD meeting with TDEC.
