**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF FOR THIRTY (30) DAYS, CONVENING A
CONTESTED CASE, AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**

This matter came before Director James M. Allison, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 9, 2015.


On March 3, 2015, Tennessee-American Water Company filed a *Petition in Support of the Calculation of the 2015 Capital Riders Reconciliation* requesting Authority approval of (1) the 2015 annual reconciliation of the Capital Riders for the 2014 review period and (2) a proposed tariff establishing the 2015 reconciliation percentage rates to become effective April 1, 2015.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to suspend the proposed tariff for thirty (30) days, convene a contested case proceeding, and appoint the Authority's General Counsel or her designee to act as Hearing Officer to prepare this matter for hearing, including establishing a procedural schedule, entering a protective order, ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues, and further suspension of the proposed tariff, if necessary.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
