
ORDER PARTIALLY GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“Authority” or “TRA”) upon an *Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time*, pursuant to rule 1220-1-1-.11, and filed contemporaneously with this Agreed Order by the Consumer Protection and Advocate Division of the Tennessee Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”). In support of its *Unopposed Motion*, the Consumer Advocate states that it has discussed this request with the attorneys for the parties, who stated that they do not oppose the Consumer Advocate’s request for extension of time from September 28, 2015 until October 5, 2015. However, given the time limits imposed upon the Authority in reaching a decision in this matter an extension to September 30, 2015, is the longest possible extension that can be granted at this time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The *Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time* to file post-hearing briefs in this matter is granted extending the filing date from September 28, 2015 to September 30, 2015.
