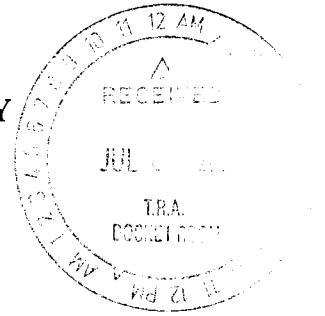

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority" or "TRA") upon an *Unopposed Motion for Leave to Issue More Than Forty Discovery Requests*, pursuant to rule 1220-1-2-.11(5)(a), upon B&W Pipeline, LLC ("B&W") filed contemporaneously with this Agreed Order by the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Tennessee Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate"). In support of its *Unopposed Motion*, the Consumer Advocate states that B&W's attorney, Henry Walker, Esq., has informed the Consumer Advocate that he does not oppose its request to issue more than forty (40) questions as part of its second discovery request.
