## ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Director James M. Allison, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 29, 2015 for the purpose of determining whether to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint a Hearing Officer.

On April 22, 2015, Eagles Nest, LLC ("Eagles Nest") filed a Petition of Eagles Nest, LLC to Require Laurel Hills Condominium Association, Inc. to Permit Connection to Water System to Eagles Nest, LLC's Property on Renegade Mountain. A Petition to Intervene was filed on May 14, 2015 by the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General. Eagles Nest has not filed an objection to the Petition to Intervene.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint the Authority's General Counsel or her designee to act as Hearing Officer to prepare this matter for hearing, including establishing a procedural schedule, entering a protective order, and ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues.
