RE: Petition of Kentucky Utilities Company for an Order Amending and Extending Authority with Respect to Revolving Line of Credit, Docket No. 15-00056; First Response to Data Request

Dear Mr. Kettles:

This letter is in response to your letter dated May 27, 2015 seeking the status of and periodic updates on the similar filings of Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") pending before the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("KPSC") and the Virginia State Corporation Commission ("VSCC").

On May 11, 2015, KU filed an Application with the KPSC (Case No. 2015-00137) requesting an order amending and extending the authority with respect to the revolving line of credit which is the subject of the above referenced TRA docket. The KPSC Application is pending and no substantive action has been taken.

On June 2, 2015, KU filed a letter with the VSCC requesting approval of an amendment and extension of the previously granted authority with respect to the revolving line of credit. The VSCC did not require a formal application; therefore the request was filed under the previous case number (Case No. PUE-2014-00031). The VSCC request is pending and no substantive action has been taken. We expect that a decision will be made before the end of June.

We will continue to provide you with periodic updates and file the orders with the TRA when they are issued by the KPSC and the VSCC. We anticipate that, as in previous dockets, TRA approval will be contingent upon approval by the KPSC and the VSCC. Therefore, we respectfully request that when the Staff completes its review, that KU's Petition be placed on the TRA Docket for consideration even if those approvals have not yet been obtained.
