
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, and Commissioner David Crowell of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on December 8, 2025. On November 17, 2015, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, now TPUC, issued an order granting RCLEC, Inc. (“RCLEC” or “Company”) a CCN to provide competing local exchange and resold interexchange telecommunications services.¹ On March 26, 2025, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its CCN because it has neither active operations nor customers in Tennessee. The Company is in good standing with the Commission and current in its payment of mandatory inspection fees. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its CCN.
