**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
FACILITIES-BASED LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**


This matter came before Vice Chair Kenneth C. Hill, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner David F. Jones of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on February 18, 2020. Local Access, LLC ("Local Access" or the "Company") was granted authority to provide competing local telecommunications services by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission"), on August 9, 2016. A final order was issued on August 15, 2016.

On September 5, 2019, the Commission received a request for cancellation of authority from Local Access. In response to a Commission inquiry, in a letter dated January 8, 2020, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee stated it is not providing any resold lines or facilities to Local Access, LLC at this time. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
