

ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“Authority” or “TRA”) to establish a procedural schedule for the orderly administration of these proceedings. The goal and design of any procedural schedule is to efficiently move the proceedings forward to a hearing and final conclusion on the merits. Nevertheless, a procedural schedule’s effectiveness directly depends on cooperation by the parties in meeting the individual benchmark dates. The Hearing Officer held a Status Conference on February 11, 2016 with the parties, Tennessee-American Water Company (“TAWC”) and the Consumer Protection and Advocate Division of the Office of the Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”), to discuss the procedural schedule. Taking into consideration the preferences of the parties, the Hearing Officer hereby establishes the Procedural Schedule set forth in **Exhibit A** attached to this Order.
