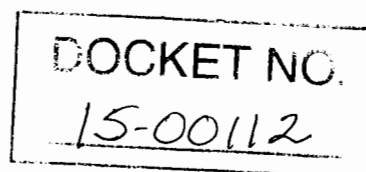

PETITION FOR TRANSFER OF AN N11 NUMBER

The United Way of Metropolitan Nashville ("Petitioner") respectfully submits this Petition for Transfer of an N11 Number (211) for the purpose of providing health and human services information and referral to citizens in East Tennessee.

INTRODUCTION

1. Petitioner is a charitable not-for-profit corporation, qualified as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code"), with its principal place of business in Nashville, Tennessee.

2. Petitioner presently holds the 2-1-1 designation for Campbell, Claiborne, Cocke, Monroe, Morgan, and Scott Counties. Petitioner filed the petition for the 2-1-1 code in the above listed counties on February 14, 2006. The designation was approved by the TRA on January 30, 2007 (docket #06-00048). Since 2006, Petitioner has taken all calls for the 2-1-1 operations in Campbell, Claiborne, Cocke, Monroe, Morgan, and Scott Counties in accordance with TRA guidelines. Petitioner now seeks to transfer the designation to the Knoxville-Knox County Community Action Committee (CAC), which has agreed to take calls for Campbell, Claiborne, Cocke, Monroe, Morgan, and Scott Counties.

REASONS FOR SUPPORTING TRANSFER OF A 2-1-1


1. Petitioner seeks transfer of the 2-1-1 abbreviated dialing code for Campbell, Claiborne, Cocke, Monroe, Morgan, and Scott Counties to Knoxville-Knox County Community Action Committee (CAC). Knox CAC has the 2-1-1 designation code for nine East Tennessee counties contiguous in geography to the six counties listed above for transfer. Knox CAC has updated and maintained the resource database of community information and referral services for its nine county area and the six additional listed counties for more than five years. Both parties have agreed to this transfer.

2. Petitioner will continue to operate 2-1-1 as designated in Bedford, Benton, Cannon, Cheatham, Chester, Clay, Coffee, Cumberland, Davidson, Decatur, DeKalb, Dickson, Fentress, Franklin, Giles, Hardin, Henry, Hickman, Humphreys, Jackson, Lawrence, Lewis, Lincoln, Macon, Marshall, Maury, Moore, Overton, Perry, Pickett, Putnam, Robertson, Rutherford, Smith, Sumner, Trousdale, Van Buren, Warren, Wayne, White, Williamson, and Wilson Counties.


Conclusion
