ORDER APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones and Director Robin Morrison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 11, 2016.

On December 17, 2015, the TRA Compliance Division as a Party opened this docket and filed a request asking the Authority to appoint a Hearing Officer to determine whether to initiate a Show Cause proceeding against Condo Villas of Gatlinburg Association, Inc. for failure to comply with the statutory and regulatory requirement to file a UD-20 Form and remit the appropriate inspection fees, and if a Show Cause is initiated, to prepare the matter for Hearing.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to appoint the Authority's General Counsel, or her designee, to act as Hearing Officer (1) to determine whether a Show Cause Order should be issued against Condo Villas of Gatlinburg Association, Inc. for alleged violations of state statutes and TRA rules; and (2) if a Show Cause Order is issued by the Hearing Officer, to prepare this matter for a hearing before the panel.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
