## ORDER APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Morrison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 14, 2016 for the purpose of determining whether to appoint a Hearing Officer. On December 17, 2015, the TRA Compliance Division as a Party opened this docket and filed a request asking the Authority to appoint a Hearing Officer to determine whether to initiate a Show Cause proceeding against Cumberland Point Condominium Property Owners Association for failure to comply with the statutory and regulatory requirements applicable to wastewater utilities, and if a Show Cause is initiated, to prepare the matter for Hearing.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to appoint the Authority's General Counsel, or her designee, to act as Hearing Officer (1) to take action as needed to facilitate investigation and discovery in this matter; (2) to determine whether a Show Cause Order should be issued against Cumberland Point Condominium Property Owners Association for alleged violations of state statutes and TRA rules regulating wastewater utilities; and (3) if a Show Cause Order is issued by the Hearing Officer, to prepare this matter for a hearing before the panel.
