ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO PLEAD AND PRACTICE PRO HAC VICE

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice* (“*Motion*”) filed by Hector Garcia, attorney for Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power (“Kingsport Power”). The *Motion* was filed on April 26, 2016.


Mr. Garcia’s *Motion* states that he is licensed, in good standing, and admitted to practice law in the State of Ohio, the Commonwealth of Virginia, and the DC Circuit and further, that no disciplinary actions or investigations are pending against him.¹ Mr. Garcia agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“Authority”) in any manner arising out of his conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Authority.

Upon review, the Hearing Officer finds that the *Motion* complies with Rule 19 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the *Motion* filed by Hector Garcia for permission to practice before the Authority in the proceedings in this matter is approved.
