Consumer Advocate to file such a Motion and the Consumer Advocate and its consultants and

expert witnesses may retain and utilize said Confidential Information obtained in Docket No. 15-

00093 in this Docket No. 16-00001, pursuant to the terms and conditions the Protective Order

entered in Docket No. 16-00001.

NOW, THEREFORE, by agreement of Kingsport and the Consumer Advocate, and for

good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. That the Consumer Advocate may retain and utilize the Confidential Information

it received in Docket No. 15-00093 in this proceeding; and

2. That the Consumer Advocate shall treat and protect said Confidential Information

as confidential in accordance with the Protective Order entered in this Docket No. 16-00001 by

the undersigned Hearing Officer.
