ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 8, 2016 for the purpose of determining whether to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint a Hearing Officer. On January 19, 2016, Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. ("TWSI") filed a Petition requesting approval of an assessment on the cabin and lot owners of the Starr Crest Resort subdivision to provide TWSI with sufficient funding to make needed repairs and improvements and to expand the on-site wastewater treatment facilities to meet the demands of the resort.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint the Authority's General Counsel, or her designee, to act as Hearing Officer to prepare this matter for hearing, including establishing a procedural schedule, entering a protective order, and ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues.
