Dear Mr. Hutton,

The City of Franklin is in receipt of your letter dated January 28, 2016, as well as the notice from Crystal Clear regarding Crystal Clear's application for state-issued certificate of franchise authority to provide cable or video service in the City of Franklin. Pursuant to your request, we submit the following information.

- 1) The City of Franklin has two (2) activated public, educational and governmental (PEG) access channels; and
- 2) The City of Franklin is not aware of a limit on the number of PEG channels that are authorized to be activated under the incumbent franchises; and
- 3) The City of Franklin does not receive any PEG support payments from the incumbent service providers. However, Comcast does pay a franchise fee in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of annual gross revenues received from the operation of the cable system to provide cable service in the franchise area.
