Trump rivals say they'll back him if nominated

DETROIT—The Republican establishment and its last best hopes to defeat Donald Trump spent a long and extraordinary day denouncing the billionaire businessman as dangerous, a “phony” and a “con man” unfit for office. Then, when it was all over, Marco Rubio, Ted Cruz and John Kasich swallowed hard and said they’d support Trump if he wins the GOP nomination.

Their pained commitments, at the end of the 11th GOP debate on Thursday, put into sharp focus the dilemma the Republican Party faces as Trump continues to dominate the race for delegates and the campaign conversation.

Anti-Trump efforts

Beyond harsh words, GOP leaders see little opportunity to stop Trump’s march toward the presidential nomination. Panicked party leaders are poring over complicated delegate math, outlining hazy scenarios for a contested national convention and even flirting with the idea of a third-party effort to derail Trump’s insurgent candidacy.

A tumultuous day opened with Mitt Romney, the party’s 2012 presidential nominee, making a rare public appearance to denounce Trump as a fraud who is “playing the American public for suckers.” Romney confidant Ron Kaufman, a senior member of the Republican National Committee, openly embraced the possibility of a contested convention, saying, “If that’s the only way to stop Trump, it makes sense.”

Also publicly criticizing Trump: House Speaker Paul Ryan, who was Romney’s running mate, and 2008 GOP nominee John McCain. Ryan said Trump’s more controversial ideas “disfigured” conservatism, and McCain voiced concern about Trump’s “uninformed and indeed dangerous statements” on national security.

Defensive words

Trump lashed back. In the evening debate in Detroit, he called Romney “a failed candidate” who lost to Barack Obama four years ago. “Obviously, he wants to be

He was also unrepentant about providing campaign contributions to leading Democrats, including 10 checks to Hillary Clinton.

“I’ve supported Democrats and I’ve supported Republicans, and as a businessman I owed that to my company, to my family, to my workers, to everybody to get along,” he said.

‘Flexibility’

When Fox News moderator Megyn Kelly told Trump his shifts caused some people to question his core, Trump insisted: “I have a very strong core. But I’ve never seen a successful person who wasn’t flexible, who didn’t have a certain degree of flexibility.”

The bad blood among the candidates flowed freely, a steady stream of insults interspersed with the policy debate. And early on in the evening, Trump nonchalantly tossed out a crude sexual reference.

Rubio justified his attacks on Trump by saying the billionaire businessman had “basically mocked everybody” over the past year. Trump countered with a feint, saying he’d called Rubio a “lightweight” in the past but “he’s really not that much of a lightweight.”

Trump University

In one particularly sharp exchange, Rubio renewed his criticisms of Trump University, which charged students \$1,495 each for seminars that would teach them the billionaire’s secrets to making it big in real estate. A lawsuit filed by the New York attorney general claims the classes fell so short of promises that it amounted to fraud.

“He’s trying to con people into giving him their vote just as he coned those people,” Rubio said.

Cruz, tag-teaming on the issue, added, “If we nominate Donald, we’re going to spend the fall and the summer with the Republican nominee facing a fraud trial.”

Trump shrugged it off, saying: “It’s a minor civil case. Give me a break.”

And he turned the tables, saying Rubio is “the real con artist.” He said the first-term senator “scammed the people of Florida” by skipping so many

Choose your play

Cover today's East-West cards. Plan the play at six clubs when West leads the Jack of hearts.

The deal arose in the final of the Senior Teams at the Fall NABC. It began a comeback for the team that won the match and the title after trailing at the half.

South won the first heart with the queen and took the trump finesse, losing. If West had exited safely, South probably would have gone down, but West questionably shifted to a spade. South played low from dummy and made his slam.

LAST HEART

A different (maybe inferior) line of play would work. South leads a trump to his ace at Trick Two. When East-West play low, South takes the A-K of hearts to pitch a diamond from dummy, ruffs his last heart, takes the ace of diamonds and ruffs a diamond. He exits with a trump, and a defender must break the spades or yield a ruff-suff.

In the replay, North-South rested at 3NT after East opened two diamonds. West led a diamond, and when the club finesse lost, the result was down two.

DAILY QUESTION

You hold: ♠ A 8 5 ♥ A K 6 5
♦ A 7 ♣ A 10 8 7. You open one club. (A 2NT opening would show

more strength.) Your partner bids one spade, you jump to 2NT and he tries three hearts. What do you say?

ANSWER: The hand is worth a slam suggestion. Bid four clubs or four diamonds as an "advance cue bid." If you lacked four-card heart support, you would bid 3NT or maybe three spades. With four cards in hearts but a less slamish hand, you would just raise to four hearts.




