
**NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT
TO CMRS INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

This Amendment to the CMRS Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment") negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee, New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC and Cricket Communications, LLC¹ was filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority") on February 16, 2016.² The Amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. The Amendment has been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement.

A Notice was filed by the Authority on March 10, 2016 advising that the Amendment would be deemed approved by the Authority within ten business days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Authority. No objection to the Amendment has been received by the Authority.

Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Authority, the Amendment is approved effective as of March 24, 2016.
