CLEC applicants are required, by statute, to demonstrate their managerial, financial and technical abilities to provide the services for which they seek authority. - 1) A bond or letter of credit pursuant to TCA §65-4-125(j). The petition indicated that a corporate surety bond was attached as Exhibit E, but there was no Exhibit E.

- 3) Is The Nexus Group, Inc. currently providing any telecommunications services to any customer in Tennessee?
