## ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE COMPETING LOCAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN TENNESSEE

This matter came before Chairman Kenneth C. Hill, Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner John Hie, and Commissioner David F. Jones of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on September 20, 2021. Mobilitie Management, LLC ("Mobilitie" or the "Company") was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Commission on July 29, 2016 in Docket No. 16-00036.

On August 20, 2021, the Commission received a request for cancellation of authority from Mobilitie. The cancellation request asserted that the company intended to voluntarily surrender its authorization. In response to a Commission inquiry, in an email dated September 8, 2021, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee confirmed that no services were being provided to Mobilitie. Therefore, as there are no

customers being served, the cancellation of its certification will have no adverse consequences for consumers in Tennessee.

Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
