NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment") negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee¹ and QuantumShift Communications, Inc.² was filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority") on May 6, 2016.³ The Amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. The Amendment has been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement.

A Notice was filed by the Authority on June 21, 2016 advising that the Amendment would be deemed approved by the Authority within ten business days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Authority. No objection to the Amendment has been received by the Authority.

Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Authority, the Amendment is approved effective as of July 5, 2016.

¹ The original interconnection agreement was filed under the name BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"). BellSouth was converted to BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee by Georgia law effective July 1, 2011.

² A name change to QuantumShift Communications, Inc. d/b/a vCom Solutions was approved by the Authority on July 28, 2008 in Docket No. 08-00112.

³ This filing is an amendment to a separate Intercarrier Compensation Agreement ("Agreement"), dated February 19, 2015, which did not include Tennessee. The Amendment adds Tennessee to the Agreement and amends the interconnection agreement that was approved by the Authority in Docket No. 06-00241 to include the Agreement.
