JOINT PETITION OF CUMBERLAND BASIN WASTEWATER SYSTEMS, LLC AND INTEGRATED RESOURCE MANAGEMENT, INC. d/b/a IRM UTILITY, INC. TO TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

Pursuant to T.C.A. § 65-4-113, Cumberland Basin Wastewater Systems, LLC ("Cumberland" or "Transferee") and Integrated Resource Management, Inc. d/b/a IRM Utility, Inc. ("IRM" or "Transferor") petition the Tennessee Regulatory Authority to approve the transfer from IRM to Cumberland of the right to provide wastewater service to a portion of Cumberland County known as Genesis Village Estates Subdivision ("Genesis Village").

In support of this Petition, the parties submit the following information:

- 1. IRM, a regulated provider of wastewater service in Tennessee, was granted the right to provide service to Genesis Village in an Order issued December 4, 2012 in TRA Docket 11-00081. At this time, the treatment and collection system at Genesis Village remains unfinished and no customers are being served by IRM.
- 2. Cumberland, also a regulated provider of wastewater services in Tennessee, currently provides wastewater service to a development in Cumberland County, Tennessee known as The Bluffs at Cumberland Cove. See TRA Docket 07-00079, Order issued November 28, 2007.
- 3. The developer of Genesis Village, Genesis Village Estates Townhomes, LLC ("the Developer") requests that the Authority transfer the right to serve Genesis Village from IRM to

Cumberland. See attached letter, **Exhibit A**. As evidenced by the filing of this Joint Petition, both utilities agree to the Developer's request.

- 4. As reflected in the record of Docket 07-00079 and in the utility's annual financial reports to the Authority, Cumberland has the managerial, technical, and financial ability to provide wastewater service at Genesis Village. Cumberland is up-to-date on all required filings at the TRA and at the Tennessee Department of Environmental Conservation ("TPEC") and has never been the subject of any enforcement proceedings at either agency.
- 5. Since IRM is not providing service to anyone at Genesis Village, it is not necessary to provide notice of this transfer to any customers. Copies of the Joint Petition are being sent to the Mayor of Cumberland County, the Mayors of Crossville, Pleasant Hill and Crab Orchard. Copies have also been mailed to the Crab Orchard Utility District and the Catoosa Utility District.
- 6. Cumberland will charge customers in Genesis Village the same rates and escrow charges approved by the Authority in Docket 07-00079.
- 7. Cumberland will apply to TDEC for a transfer to Cumberland of the State Operating Permit held by IRM to operate a wastewater treatment system at Genesis Village. Upon completion of the transfer of the State Operating Permit, Cumberland will file the State Operating Permit with the Authority.
- 8. Based on consideration of all of those factors, including the agreement of both utilities and the Developer, this transfer of authority will further the public interest.

Conclusion

The parties therefore ask that this Joint Petition be approved and that the operating rights to provide wastewater service to Genesis Village, as more particularly described in the record of Docket 11-00081, be transferred to Cumberland pursuant to T.C.A. § 65-4-113.
