On July 5, 2016, CallCatchers Inc. d/b/a FreedomVoice Systems ("FreedomVoice"), filed an Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Provide Resold Interexchange Telecommunications Services. Subsequently, on November 15, 2016, GoDaddy Operating Company, LLC ("GoDaddy Operating") acquired FreedomVoice.
