ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Vice Chairman Robin L. Morrison, Director Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 13, 2017 for the purpose of determining whether to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint a Hearing Officer. On August 22, 2016, Cartwright Creek, L.L.C. and Arrington National Development, LLC filed a joint petition requesting approval of a Sewer and Wastewater Treatment System Service Agreement for the provision of wastewater service to a development located in Williamson County, Tennessee, known as the Hideaway at Arrington.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint the Authority's General Counsel, or her designee, to act as Hearing Officer to prepare this matter for hearing, with authority to handle all preliminary matters, including but not limited to, establishing a procedural schedule, considering dispositive motions, ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues, and entering a protective order, as needed.
