ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO WITHDRAW

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Joint Motion to Withdraw* (“*Joint Motion*”) filed by Cartwright Creek, LLC (“Cartwright Creek”) and Arrington National Development, LLC (“Arrington”) on February 21, 2018. In the *Joint Motion*, Cartwright Creek and Arrington seek to withdraw the *Joint Petition of Cartwright Creek LLC and Arrington National Development, LLC for Approval Nunc Pro Tunc of Special Contract*. Further, the *Joint Motion* states that the Consumer Protection and Advocate Division of the Office of the Attorney General has no objection to the *Joint Motion*.¹ Consequently, the parties request that this docket be dismissed without prejudice to the parties’ ability to re-file a similar petition at a later date.

It should be noted that future petitions seeking approval of special contracts should be filed in advance of execution so that such approvals do not require retroactive action, or a *nunc pro tunc* order of the Commission. However, the Hearing Officer finds that the parties’ request in the *Joint Motion* is well-taken and should be approved.
