Re: Declaration of Force Majeure Event

Dear Chairman Jones:

Pursuant to Section 4.5.2 of AT&T Tennessee's Self Effectuating Enforcement Mechanisms Administration Plan ("SEEM Plan"), AT&T Tennessee hereby declares a force majeure event due to the wildfires that began November 28, 2016 and continues to impact AT&T Tennessee's operations. The Governor has declared a state of emergency in these areas.

The Service Quality Measures ("SQMs") impacted due to this event include all measures associated with Provisioning, Maintenance & Repair, and Trunk Group Performance.

AT&T Tennessee submits the attached spreadsheet, Attachment A, identifying all wire centers affected by the wildfires. AT&T Tennessee will notify the Commission when this force majeure event period has concluded.
