**ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE  
AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Director Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 13, 2017 for the purpose of determining whether to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint a Hearing Officer. On February 8, 2017, Integra Water Tennessee, LLC filed a petition for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide wastewater service to the Casey Cove Subdivision located in DeKalb County, Tennessee, and for approval of a tariff and other charges for service. The Consumer Protection and Advocate Division of the Office of the Attorney General filed a *Petition to Intervene* on March 6, 2017.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint the Authority's General Counsel, or her designee, to act as Hearing Officer to prepare this matter for hearing, with authority to handle all preliminary matters, including but not limited to, establishing a procedural schedule, considering dispositive motions, ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues, and entering a protective order, as needed.
