

To assist the Authority in its evaluation of the above-captioned Petition filed on February 8, 2017, it is requested that the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division provide a response to the following:

On June 5, 2018, Integra Water Tennessee, LLC filed the *Petitioner's Third Amended Petition* and *Second Amended Tariff*. The amended filing proposes a reduction in the monthly sewer rate from \$90.00 to \$82.00, and introduces a System Access Fee of \$84.00 annually to lot owners until such time a dwelling connects to the completed wastewater system. Please provide a written response containing the Consumer Advocate's position on this modified rate structure and whether the Consumer Advocate agrees to modify the Settlement Agreement previously filed in this docket.

It is requested that all responses be provided no later than 2:00 p.m., Wednesday July 11, 2018. In accordance with TPUC rules, submit either (1) original and thirteen written copies of your response or (1) original and four written copies and an
