On July 5, 2018, you requested a response from the Consumer Advocate on the following question:

On June 5, 2018, Integra Water Tennessee, LLC filed the *Petitioner's Third Amended Petition* and *Second Amended Tariff* The amended filing proposes a reduction in the monthly sewer rate from \$90.00 to \$82.00 and introduces a System Access Fee of \$84.00 annually to lot owners until such time a dwelling connects to the completed wastewater system. Please provide a written response containing the Consumer Advocate's position on this modified rate structure and whether the Consumer Advocate agrees to modify the Settlement Agreement previously filed in this docket.

On July 6, 2018, the Consumer Advocate filed the *Amended Stipulation and Settlement Agreement* in which the Parties agreed to a monthly sewer rate of \$82.00 and the addition of a System Access Fee of \$84.00. The Consumer Advocate believes the filing of the *Amended Stipulation and Settlement Agreement* is responsive to your inquiry of June 5th. If the TPUC Staff needs additional clarification, please let the Consumer Advocate know so we can respond further.
