**MOTION TO TAKE ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE**

Comes now the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC” or “Commission”) Staff as a party (“Party Staff” or “Petitioner”) in accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-313(6) and § 65-2-109(4) and requests that the Commission take administrative notice of all filings in this docket. In support of its Motion, Party Staff would state as follows:

1. Under the provisions of the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act (“UAPA”) Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-313(6)(A) states, in relevant part, that official notice may be taken of any fact that could be judicially noticed in the courts of this state.

2. The Commission is also permitted to take notice of facts in accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-109(4), which states, in relevant part:

The commission may take notice of judicial cognizable facts and, in addition, may take notice of general, technical, or scientific facts within its specialized knowledge. Parties shall be notified either before or during the hearing, or by reference in preliminary reports or otherwise, of the material so noticed, and they shall be afforded an opportunity to contest the facts so noted.

3. Party Staff moves that the Commission take administrative notice of all filings in the instant case, TPUC Docket No. 17-00014. Party Staff asserts that these documents are official published records of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission.

For the foregoing reasons, Party Staff moves that the Commission take administrative notice of all filed documents for consideration in this docket.


