This letter is a follow-up to the June 1, 2017 status conference. In this status conference, Integra Water stated it would file discovery and data request responses with TPUC shortly. Integra Water filed its responses on June 5, 2017. Also, discussed during the June 1<sup>st</sup> status conference was a deadline of June 8<sup>th</sup> for Integra Water to address deficiencies in its proposed tariff and petition. The discovery and data request responses filed on June 5<sup>th</sup> do not address the deficiencies identified by Consumer Advocate.

The Consumer Advocate is committed to working with Integra Water on a new procedural schedule; however, it cannot do so until deficiencies in the proposed tariff and petition are addressed. Therefore, we request another status conference to obtain guidance on how to proceed.
