
ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "TPUC") for consideration of the request to withdraw the *Initial [sic] Petition for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by Integra Water Tennessee, LLC* ("Petition") to serve Hardeman Springs Subdivision. In its request, Integra Water Tennessee, LLC ("Integra") states Hardeman Springs Subdivision is in the service territory of Cartwright Creek, LLC; therefore, Integra cannot serve this development and needs to withdraw its *Petition*.<sup>1</sup> The Hearing Officer finds that the request is well-taken and should be approved.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. The request to withdraw the *Initial [sic] Petition for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by Integra Water Tennessee, LLC* filed by Integra Water Tennessee, LLC is granted.
2. The Docket Manager is directed to close this docket file.

<sup>1</sup> Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-203 prohibits the Commission from issuing a certificate of public convenience and necessity to a utility that will be in direct competition with another utility, unless the Commission first determines the existing public utility is inadequate to meet the needs of the public.
