
Question:

1. On page 33 of your direct testimony you state the "typical residential customer living in the City of Chattanooga, and using an average of 4,154 gallons per month will see an increase in their bill of \$0.35 per month, or \$3.15 in 2017."

Can you please update this statement based upon the revised exhibits submitted to TPUC on August 4, 2017.

Response:

Based on the revised exhibits submitted to TPUC on August 4, 2017, the average residential customer living in the City of Chattanooga, and using an average of 4,154 gallons per month will see an increase in their bill of \$0.19 per month, or \$2.28 per year in 2017. The impact of all of the surcharges, including the authorized 2017 Capital Riders of 13.95%, the authorized PCOP of -0.89%, and the proposed reconciliation capital riders amount of 0.906% for the average residential customer living in the City of Chattanooga is \$3.01 per month.
