ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF THROUGH JUNE 1, 2017

This matter is before the Hearing Officer, duly appointed by the voting panel of Commissioners of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) and designated by General Counsel, to administer certain preliminary issues that may arise during the preparation of this matter for hearing before the Commission. On March 1, 2017, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103 *et seq.*, Tennessee-American Water Company (“TAWC” or the “Company”) filed a petition regarding its annual Capital Recovery Riders’ reconciliation along with the proposed tariffs.

Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103(a) permits the Commission, pending a hearing and determination, to suspend any rate increase, change, or alteration for an initial period not to exceed three months from the proposed effective date of such increase, change, or alteration.¹ Because the Commission’s investigation, hearing, and final determination on the Company’s proposed tariff cannot be completed prior to the effective date, the Hearing Officer hereby

suspends the effectiveness of the tariff through June 1, 2017.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of proposed TRA NO. 19 Ninth Revised Sheet No. 12-Riders-1 filed by Tennessee-American Water Company on March 1, 2017, is hereby suspended **through June 1, 2017**, or until further order of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission, whichever occurs sooner.
