# EAST TENNESSEE ENERGY CONSUMERS DISCOVERY RESPONSES TO KINGSPORT POWER COMPANY d/b/a AEP APPALACHIAN POWER (First Set)

Intervenor East Tennessee Energy Consumers ("ETEC") provides the following responses to the Discovery Requests of Petitioner Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power.

1. Has ETEC witness Baron ever testified as to the appropriate use of riders, rate adjustment clauses, or similar mechanisms in any docket in any state? If yes, please identify the state and the case or docket number for each filing. If the documents (testimony, orders, *etc.*.) for each case are not available electronically, please provide copies.

**Response:** ETEC objects to Kingsport's Request No. 1 as overly broad, unduly burdensome and beyond the scope of discovery in this matter. Mr. Baron has testified in approximately 400 cases over 40 years. He does not know each and every case in which

he addressed riders, etc. Subject to and without waiving the foregoing objection, See Exhibit (SJB-1). Notwithstanding this, as stated in his direct testimony Mr. Baron testified in WV Case No. 14-1152-E-42T on the issue of a vegetation management surcharge rider for Appalachian Power. His testimony in WV Case No. 14-0702-E-42T addressed a vegetation management surcharge rider for Monongahela Power Company and The Potomac Edison Company. Those testimonies are available on the Public Service Commission of West Virginia's website.
