
**NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT
TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

This Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment") negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T") and DeltaCom, LLC d/b/a EarthLink Business ("DeltaCom") was filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") on June 1, 2017.¹ The Amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. The Amendment has been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement.

A Notice was filed by the Commission on June 28, 2017 advising that the Amendment would be deemed approved by the Commission within ten business days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Commission. No objection to the Amendment has been received by the Commission.

Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Commission, the Amendment is approved effective as of July 12, 2017.

¹ An amendment filed in Docket No. 15-00095 added DeltaCom as a party to the underlying interconnection agreement in Docket No. 11-00175 between AT&T and Business Telecom, LLC d/b/a EarthLink Business III and terminated the interconnection agreement between AT&T and DeltaCom which was approved in Docket No. 11-00176. Subsequent amendments were filed and approved in Docket Nos. 16-00049 and 16-00104.
