

Re: Numbering Waiver Request-Volunteer First Services, Inc.

JSI, Inc., as consultant for Volunteer First Services, Inc., OCN 451C, is requesting a numbering waiver to obtain a one thousand (1K) block of numbers from the Pooling Administrator, in the Crossville, TN rate center.

Volunteer First Services, Inc. has received a request from Covenant Health for a single, consecutive 1K block of numbers in Crossville, TN, in order to accommodate numbering assignments at the Cumberland Medical Center. Currently, Volunteer First has three (3), 1K block assignments in Crossville: 931-787-1, 931-210-5 and 931-250-5. But, all blocks have been utilized in part.

Due to Volunteer First Services, Inc. not qualifying for a growth block based on Months to Exhaust (MTE) calculations, the Pooling Administrator has denied the request for a new block assignment in Crossville. Therefore, it is necessary for Volunteer First Services, Inc. to make this numbering waiver request.
