To assist the Commission in its review of Monster Broadband, Inc.'s application for certificate of convenience and necessity to provide competing local telecommunications services in Tennessee, you are requested to provide the following:

- 1) How many voice customers does Monster Broadband, Inc. currently serve?
- 2) Exhibit 2, "Partnership Agreement, Articles of Organization and Tennessee Secretary of State Authorization" was not included in the application. Please provide those items.
- 3) Exhibit 4, "Financial Statements" was not included in the application. Please provide Financial Statements, including balance sheet, income statement, and statement of cash flows for the previous three (3) years.
- 4) Provide projected financials for Monster Broadband, Inc. for the next three (3) years.
- 5) Provide a capital expenditures forecast for the fiber project described in the application. Include proof of the line of credit referenced in the application and provide the terms of the letter of credit.
- 6) Provide the original surety bond referenced as Exhibit 9. The application included a copy of the bond.
- 7) Have there been any complaints filed against Monster Broadband, Inc. with the Federal Communications Commission or the Better Business Bureau? If so, provide details of the complaints, including how they were remedied.

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 pm on July 28, 2017 and that you reference Docket Number 17-00065 on the response. In accordance with TRA rules submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version.
