

Dear Mr. Twomey,

The Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC") is in receipt of Monster Broadband, Inc.'s response to our initial data request. However, the TPUC requires the following information before action on Monster Broadband, Inc.'s application can proceed:

- 1) Provide the original surety bond issued to Monster Broadband, Inc. by RLI Insurance Company. The initial application contained a copy and the response to our initial data request also contained a copy of the bond.
- 2) Provide the company's balance sheet and cash flow statement for the time period January 2016 through December 2016. A profit and loss statement for 2016 was included in Monster Broadband, Inc.'s initial response to our data request. Also, provide balance sheets, profit and loss statements and cash flow statements for 2014 and 2015.
- 3) Provide a detailed discussion describing and detailing the expenses contained in the following items listed in the profit and loss statement for January 2016 through December 2016:

*Fuel	\$19,340.73
*Credit Card Fees	\$10,709.79
*Transfer of Money	\$30,450.00
*Materials and Supplies	\$239,201.31
*Repairs & Maintenance	\$38,964.53
*Rubbage Removal Supplies	\$12,155.87
*Taxes / 941	\$141,416.96
*Total Utilities	\$33,836.38

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 pm on November 22, 2017 and that you reference Docket Number 17-00065 on the response. In accordance with TRA rules submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version.
