

ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION FOR DISMISSAL AND CLOSING DOCKET

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Joint Motion for Voluntary Dismissal with Prejudice* (“*Joint Motion*”) filed by Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power (“KPC”) and Bristol Tennessee Essential Services (“BTES”) on February 16, 2018. In the *Joint Motion*, KPC and BTES state that “all issues related to this Docket have been resolved, compromised and settled.”¹ Consequently, the parties request that this docket be dismissed with prejudice. The Hearing Officer finds that the parties’ request in the *Joint Motion* is well-taken and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The *Joint Motion for Voluntary Dismissal with Prejudice* filed by Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power and Bristol Tennessee Essential Services is granted and the docket is administratively closed.
