

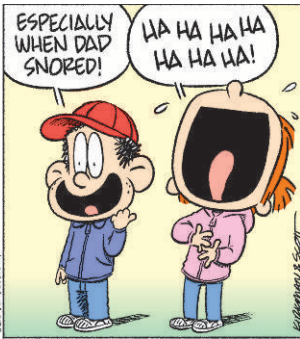

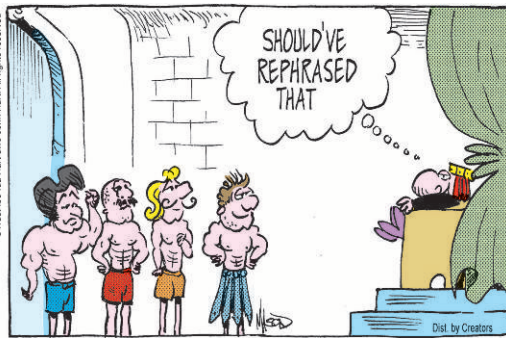

pany) filed a Petition with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (TPUC) on August 31, 2017 in Docket 17-00091, pro-
posing to change its rates for natural gas service now in effect. The rates proposed by the Company are subject to approval
by the TPUC. The TPUC may adopt, reject, increase or decrease any of the proposed rates in part or in whole. A complete
copy of the proposed rate changes and the reasons for them are on file with the TPUC and are available for public inspection.
A complete copy is also available in the Company's local offices. The Company has requested this change in rates in accor-
dance with the procedures approved in its Annual Review Mechanism tariff. The predicted impact of the proposed changes
on the average residential customer is an increase of approximately \$1.59 per year. The predicted impact of the proposed
changes on the average small commercial class customer is an increase of approximately \$6.67 per year. The matter is set
for hearing January 16th, 2018, beginning at 1:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as it may be heard, in the TPUC's Hearing

est and most expensive to be constructed in downtown Franklin, will bring a luxury Curio Hilton 119-room hotel, 150-unit “high-end” apartments, and multiple shops all under the roof of a LEED Gold building, plus add paid public parking spaces in a garage. The hotel will be managed by Euan McGlashan and Valor Hospitality, whose Cape Grace Hotel in Cape Town, South Africa has been recognized by Condé Nast as the “Best Hotel in the World.”

Stephens Valley brings broad scale development

The Stephens Valley \$1 billion mixed-use development, which touches the borders of both Williamson and Davidson counties off Sneed Road, opened its Welcome Center in November. The development will eventually bring approximately 1,200 homes and 80,000 square feet of retail space as well as office space to the area.

The site spans about 988 acres, surrounded on three sides by the Natchez Trace Parkway, which is part of the National Parks System.

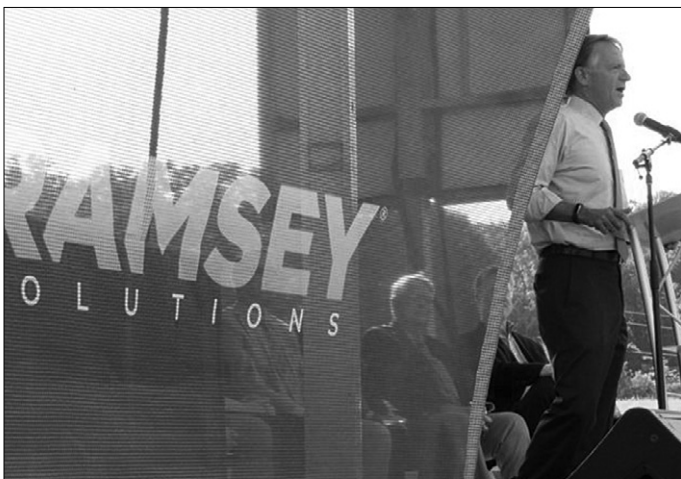
The development met some controversy with preservationists and homeowners along the corridor last year. Preservationists argue that the development threatens the scenic area, where the historic Old Natchez Trace roadway intersects Sneed, by bringing more traffic. Signs of protest sprinkled along Sneed Road in homeowners yards, labeled “Stop Rochford.” Although, the developer made \$11.4 million worth of road improvements off and on-site to accommodate traffic.

The Williamson County side will bring 793 single-family homes, starting in the upper \$400,000s to over \$1 million, while the Davidson County side will offer a few hundred townhomes and flats, starting in the \$230,000s.

Colletta Park passes

After a two-year, long-fought battle, the Colletta Park development, with modifications, was narrowly approved 4-3 by the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

Many residents who live around the proposed Colletta Park subdivision which was annexed into the city of Franklin opposed its density and traffic that the neighborhood would bring,

plus argued that the plans conflicted with the city’s existing character overlay ordinances. However, despite protest for almost 2 years, BOMA approved the subdivision that will bring 199 units to 199 acres, located south of Murfreesboro Road and north of South Carothers Parkway.

Headquarters come to Franklin

The headquarters introduced over 120 jobs to Franklin and the greater Nashville area.

Williamson County Mayor Rogers Anderson, Franklin Mayor Ken Moore spoke at the ribbon-cutting ceremony and Nashville mascots and cheerleaders for sports teams such as, the Predators, Tennessee Titans and Sounds attended the celebration for photo opportu-

ity in Thompson’s Station, a pet food factory in Lebanon and two Mars Wrigley Confectionary production facilities in Cleveland and Chattanooga.

Berry Farms brings headquarters, new business to southeast

In Franklin’s southern corridor, corporate development at Berry Farms is bringing a new dimension of business, retail, eateries and corporate headquarters to once rural farmland in Franklin. The first large-scale hotel of its kind off I-65 in south Franklin, Hampton Inn & Suites opened late last year.

Plentiful sprouting business as well as events held at the nearby Williamson County Ag Park was the catalyst for the need of a hotel.

Renowned financial advisor and radio talk show host Dave Ramsey paid \$50 million cash for the relocation of Ramsey Solutions headquarters on 47-acres in Berry Farms. Gov. Bill Haslam

and locally elected officials attended the groundbreaking in July of the first building on site consisting of 223,000 square feet expected in August 2019.

The growing company decided to move its operations from its previous 150,000 square feet of office space spread through various spots in Cool Springs. The company plans to add 175 team members in the next year and nearly 400 team members by 2023 and again by 2028. The popular radio

program, “The Dave Ramsey Show” commemorated its 25th anniversary last year airing to 13 million listeners every week.

Factor in the drain of the cross-country flight back to Athens from Pasadena, California and the fact players returned to classes this week following the Christmas break, and Smart believed there was reason to worry about the preparation for Monday night’s game against Alabama for the national title.

As soon as last week’s Rose Bowl semifinal playoff win was over, Smart began addressing those concerns with his players. “A very emotional game ... which concerns me, and I talked to the players immediately afterward about not burning any more energy or emotion on that game and moving on,” Smart said earlier this week.

Smart and two players, running

“I want to make sure these players understand that, because a lot of them don’t,” Smart said. “They don’t understand that 20 minutes with the media, 45 minutes waiting on a bus or two hours waiting in traffic, those all add up. ... That’s what’s important to me is to lead these young men the right direction so they have the best opportunity at success as they can have.”

Both Georgia and Alabama are expected to arrive in Atlanta on Friday night.

Michel and Smith say the Bulldogs won’t have any difficulty moving past the emotions of the dramatic 54-48 Rose Bowl win over Oklahoma. After all, this is the opportunity to play for No. 3 Georgia’s first national championship since 1980.

“We’ve won games around here, so we know how to handle situations like this,” said Michel, who scored the game-winning touchdown on a direct snap. “We know our task at hand. We’ve just got to move forward. We’ve got a big, a good opponent we’re about to face, so I’m sure this team, this coaching staff knows what we’ve

got to focus on from here on.”

Smith, named the defensive player of the game in the Rose Bowl, said players understand the win was only a step to the team’s ultimate goal.

“We just have to shift our focus back because the main thing is to win the national championship, and we know that if we’re not honed in and doing everything we can in our power to prepare ourselves for that game, then we know we’ll be shorting ourselves,” Smith said. “... I think we’ll be 100 percent, though, for sure.”

The matchup of Southeastern Conference rivals will cap an emotion-packed week for Smart. He coached with Saban at LSU, the Miami Dolphins and for nine years with Alabama, the last eight as defensive coordinator. Smart coached on four national championship teams at Alabama, but those titles belong to Saban.

Saban is 11-0 when coaching against his former assistants. Smart is trying to beat his former boss as well as end Georgia’s 38-year national championship drought.

back Sony Michel and linebacker Roquan Smith, participated in a teleconference with reporters on Tuesday. Otherwise, Smart has shielded his players from interviews before Saturday’s media day at Philips Arena.

Smart, the former longtime defensive coordinator under Alabama coach Nick Saban, said players may not realize how the demands of the week can cut into time he wants to devote to preparing for the game.

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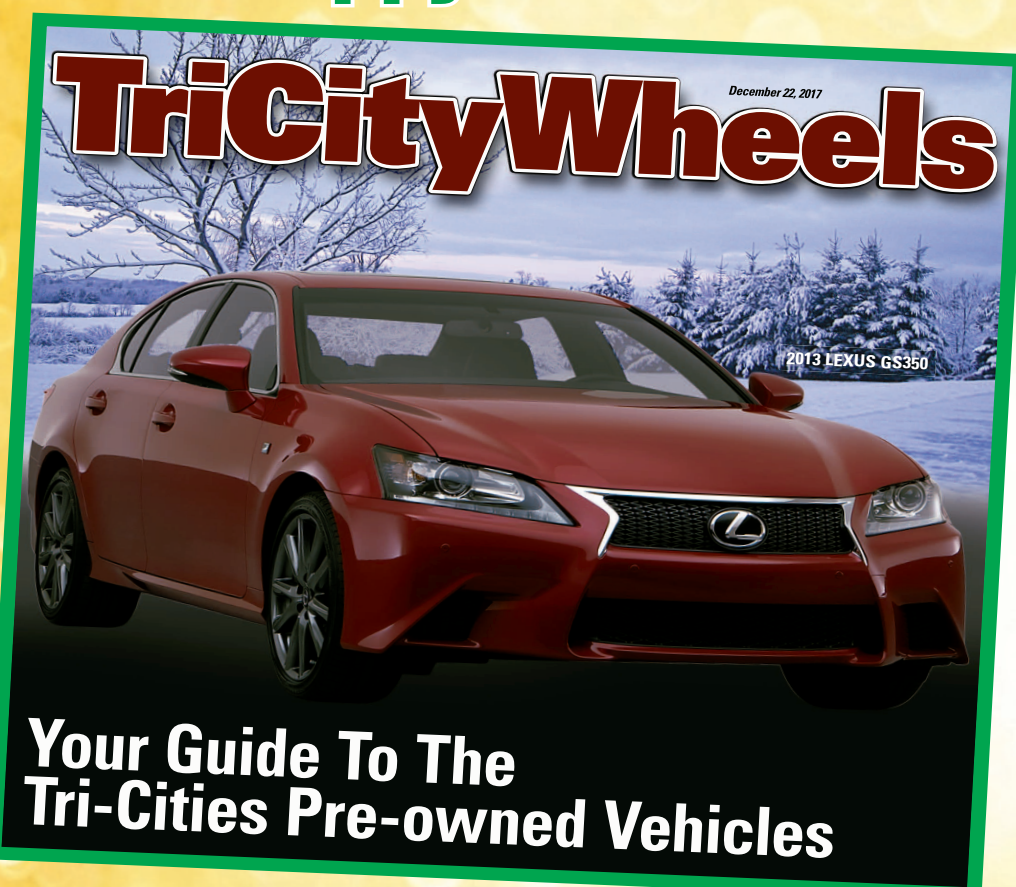
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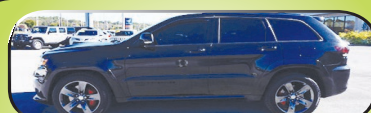

Sessions rescinds pot ruling; legal dealers face uncertainty

WASHINGTON — Attorney General Jeff Sessions has rescinded an Obama-era policy that paved the way for legalized marijuana to flourish in states

across the country, creating new confusion about enforcement and use just three days after a new legalization law went into effect in California.



Sessions

President Donald Trump's top law enforcement official announced the change Thursday. Instead of the previous lenient-federal-enforcement policy, Sessions' new stance will instead let federal prosecutors where marijuana is legal decide how aggressively to enforce longstanding federal law prohibiting it.

Criticism

Sessions' plan drew immediate strong objection from Republican Sen. Cory Gardner of Colorado, one of eight states that have legalized marijuana for recreational use.

Gardner said in a tweet that the Justice Department "has trampled on the will of the voters" in Colorado and other states. He said the action would contradict what Sessions had told him before the attorney general was confirmed and that he was prepared "to take all steps necessary" to fight the step including holding up the confirmation of Justice Department nominees.

Sessions rescinded the policy by president Barack Obama's Justice Department that has generally barred fed-

eral law enforcement officials from interfering with marijuana sales in states where the drug is legal.

"In deciding which marijuana activities to prosecute under these laws with the Department's finite resources, prosecutors should follow the well-established principles that govern all federal prosecutions," by considering the seriousness of the crime and its impact on the community, Sessions wrote in a one-page memo to the nation's federal prosecutors.

More confusion

The move by Trump's attorney general likely is sure to add to confusion about whether it's OK to grow, buy or use marijuana in states where the drug is legal.

It comes just after shops opened in California, launching what is expected to become the world's largest market for legal recreational marijuana and as polls show a solid majority of Americans believe the drug should be legal.

While Sessions has been carrying out a Justice Department agenda that follows Trump's top priorities on such issues as immigration and opioids, the changes to marijuana policy reflect his own concerns. Trump's personal views on marijuana remain largely unknown.

Sessions, who has assailed marijuana as comparable to heroin and has blamed it for spikes in violence, had been expected to ramp up enforcement. Marijuana advocates argue that legalizing the drug eliminates the need for a black market and will likely reduce violence, since criminals would no longer control the marijuana trade.
