TPUC DATA REQUEST

Reference Atmos Energy Murfreesboro Settlement Agreement and Safety Inspection Evaluation Report No. 17-011.

1. Provide the Account to which the \$500,000 settlement payment of March 31, 2017 was recorded. Include journal entries and documentation as to whether the \$500,000 was included for recovery in TPUC Docket 17-00012 or this docket.
2. Provide the total amount spent from March 23, 2017 through May 31, 2017 related to the \$1,777,600 civil penalty to enhance safety of Atmos energy owned gas pipeline systems within the state of Tennessee.
 - Provide the account to which each amount was recorded; and
 - Provide the account to which any related amortization or depreciation was recorded.
